- Troubleshooting when nutrition interventions aren't working

The presenter was very knowledgeable and she went through this topic step by step by explaining many applications and guidelines in regards to neonatal nutrition support.

I have learned the importance of nutrition on extremely premature infants born <28 weeks gestation, without proper feeding care they are at risk to die.

Additionally, the presenter covered gestational age classification, how to read growth charts and growth terminology.

How to make a nutrition assessment and make a proper diagnosis of malnutrition, nutritional needs, calorie & macronutrient needs, especially protein needs, medications, and fluid balance.
